Personally appeared before me DAVID ROYAL and made oath that on or about the 28th day of October, 2010, in said County, and within the jurisdiction of the Criminal Court of Shelby County, Tennessee, one Kendrick D Watson, age 30, sex Male, whose last known address is 3225 Keystone, Memphis, TN 38128, did unlawfully commit the offense(s) of Violation of Seat Belt Law (T.C.A. 55-9-603), Possess Controlled Substance w/i to Manufacture/Deliver/Sell (T.C.A. 39-17-417). To Wit: Hydrocodone Pills and the essential facts constituting said offense(s) and the source of the affiant's information are as follows:


Detectives were in the area Stage Rd and Beverly Hills checking for criminal activity in the various Apartments in that area. Detective Graves and Norris observed a Silver Chevy HHR bearing TN tag 578YDT registered in Blount County. Detectives observed this vehicle circling around inside the Beverly Hills Apartments. Detectives noticed the passenger was not wearing a seatbelt. Detectives ran the tag and the vehicle came back registered to a rental car company out of Tulsa, Oklahoma. Detectives conducted a traffic stop to this vehicle as it exited the Beverly Hills Apartments to North Bound Beverly Hills. The vehicle then turned inside the Cedar Woods Apartment complex and stopped.

Once stopped, Detective Graves spoke to the driver Defendant Lamario Porter and he advised he did not have a license. Detective Norris observed 2 10MG Hydrocodone pills Blue in color in plain view sitting inside the front cup holder near the gear selector. Detectives then detained both driver Lamario Porter and front passenger Kendrick Watson.

Detective McDonald ran Defendant Porter info via PDA and it showed to be suspended on 05/13/08 for Failure to satisfy Citation and also showed him to have an active Misdemeanor Warrant for Criminal Trespass. Detective Graves searched the vehicle and located 4 clear plastic bags that contained 359 (10 MG) Hydrocodone pills total and \$430 cash inside the rear storage compartment inside the hatchback trunk area. All pills located were Blue, Green, and Yellow in color.

Detective McDonald located \$463 cash inside Defendant Watson's right front pocket. Detective Norris located \$111 cash inside Defendant Porter's left front pocket. Detective McDonald located a rental agreement with the passenger Defendant Watson's name and Misc mail with his name and address inside the glovebox. Detectives towed the rental vehicle to the city lot. Detective Norris verified the pills via Drug Identification Bible.


Both Defendants were transported to Peres and Hollywood at which time the evidence and Defendants were turned over to Sgt Pulley and Detective Royal who were operating the Blue Crush Transport vehicle #1. Both Defendants and evidence were then transported to 201 Poplar at which time the pill count was verified by the Property Room Tech. The total evidence tagged was 361 (10 MG) Hydrocodone Pills and \$1004 Cash. These events occurred in Shelby County, Tennessee.
