Personally appeared before me Isaac H. Lamar and made oath that on or about the 1st day of Oct, 2011, in said County, and within the jurisdiction of the Criminal Court of Shelby County, Tennessee, one Kendrick D Watson, age 31, sex Male, whose last known address is 3225 Keystone, Memphis, TN 38128, did unlawfully commit the offense(s) of Disorderly Conduct (T.C.A. 39-17-305), Criminal Trespass (T.C.A. 39-14-405) and the essential facts constituting said offense(s) and the source of the affiant's information are as follows:

Officer on routine call where the def was standing on the lot and was asked to leave. Officers left the location and returned and the def was again asked to leave. Officers attempted approach the def and he attempted to run inside of the establishment located at 1235 Hollywood. Officers attempted to detain the def and he snatched back threatening officers that if she touched him he would strike her. After a brief struggle the def was detained and walked back to the squad car were he continued to curse at officers causing a large crowd to gather to see what was going on. The def was arrested and transported to 201 Poplar. These events occurred in Shelby County, Tennessee.
