## ORDER APPOINTING CJA COUNSEL

Before the court is the motion of the defendant, Alton Ray Mills, to have counsel appointed under the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006a for appellate purposes. The motion was filed January 7, 1999, by retained counsel, James D. Causey and A C Wharton, Jr. The motion was referred to the United States Magistrate Judge for determination.

In support of his motion, the defendant has submitted an affidavit of indigency, under penalty of perjury, November 30, 1998. The affidavit states that the defendant is unemployed, having last worked on October 1, 1997. It further states that defendant has no source of income, has not received any income within the past twelve months, has no other assets or any means to pay counsel.

It appears to the court from the affidavit of the defendant This document entered on docket sheet in compliance with Rule 55 and / or

that he lacks sufficient financial resources to employ counsel to

pursue an appeal and that he does not wish to waive counsel on

appeal. Thus, the above-named defendant is qualified for

appointment of counsel under 18 U.S.C. § 3006a.

Mr. Causey and Mr. Wharton have indicated by affidavit their

willingness to represent the defendant on appeal as appointed

counsel. Because of their familiarity with the file and in the

interests of justice, the court finds that it is appropriate to

appoint private counsel to represent defendant in this matter

instead of the Federal Public Defender. The Federal Public

Defender has been contacted and concurs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that retained counsel, A C Wharton,

Jr. and James D. Causey, be and hereby are appointed under the

Criminal Justice Act to represent the above-named defendant on

appeal unless relieved by order of this court or by order of the

court of appeals.
