AFFIDAVIT OF COMPLAINT

PERSONALLY APPEARED BEFORE ME, B. TALFORD MPD #11707, and made oath that on or about the 19 day of Sept, 20 18, in said County, and within the jurisdiction of the Criminal Court of Shelby, Tennessee, one Theryon C. Bond, did unlawfully commit the offense Obstructing Highway/Passageway (T.C.A. 39-17-307) and Disorderly Conduct (T.C.A. 39-17-305)

Further, affiant makes oath that the essential facts constituting said offense(s), the source of affiant's information, and the reason why the affiant's information is believable concerning said facts are as follows:

On 09/19/18 at approx 2120 hrs Ofc F. Smith (263) and M. Allen (1229) responded to a disturbance in front of 1433 Elvis Presley Blvd. Upon arrival, Ofc observed a large crowd with interlocked arms sitting in the street on Elvis Presley Blvd near Kerr blocking the flow of NIS and other traffic. Lt. Moses (704C) made the scene and ordered the crowd to disperse from the street in five seconds or they would be arrested. Lt. Moses performed a five second count-down on a PA. Following the count multiple individuals remained in the street, prompting Ofc to begin effecting arrests. While doing so, A/Ds observed a FIB, later identified as defendant Theryon Bond, charge into Elvis Presley Blvd in an aggressive manner towards other MPD Ofcs. This was following the initial dispersal order. Ofc Smith ordered def Bond to get out of the street, however, she refused to comply with Ofc lawful orders. Ofc Smith and Allen placed hands on def Bond and took her into custody. Det. Bond was transported to Jail East.
