PERSONALLY APPEARED BEFORE ME, C. Paige #12334, and made oath that on or about the 27th day of December, 2010, in said County, and within the jurisdiction of the Criminal Court of Shelby, Tennessee, one, Ashley L. Egan did unlawfully commit the offense Theft of Property \$1,000 to \$10,000 to wit Motor Vehicle

Further, affiant makes oath that the essential facts constituting said offense(s), the source of affiant's information, and the reason why the affiant's information is believable concerning said facts are as follows: On Monday, December 13, 2010 Comp. Tuterrance Davis at approximately 0054 hours in Carlisle, AR from clerk at Conoco Store reported his 2001 Chevy Tahoe TN Tags 474 VYB VIN# 1GNEK13T41J181375 4-door Green valued by NADA at \$8,050.00 to Carlisle Police Department.

On 12/27/10 at 0003 hours, Officers received information police dispatcher that comp. Tuterrance Davis saw his stolen 2001 Chevy Tahoe Green with TN Tags 474 VYB VIN# 1GNEK13T41J181375 headed eastbound on I-40 and Sycamore View. Officers talked with Comp. Tuterrance Davis at Sycamore View and Shelby Oaks where he advised Ashley Egan F/W was observed driving his stolen vehicle. Comp. later located his stolen vehicle again on the lot at 1585 Sycamore View parked in the rear of the hotel. Officers contacted police dispatcher which they confirmed the vehicle to be stolen out of Carlisle, AR under RI# 1001169, NCIC# V684089002. Officers knocked at the door of room# 136, the defendant Ashley Egan met them at the door and presented a TN State issued I.D. she was placed under arrest without incident. Defendant was transport to Felony Response and waived her Miranda Rights. She admitted driving the vehicle.

This occurred in Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee.

Harris and made oath that on or about the 20th day of December, 2010, in said County, and within the jurisdiction of the Criminal Court of Shelby County, Tennessee, one Ashley Egan, age 27 sex Female, whose last known address is 3522 Carney, did unlawfully commit the offense(s) of Theft of Property less than \$ 500 T.C.A. 39-14-103 and the essential facts constituting said offense(s) and the source of the affiant's information are as follows:

On December 03, 2010 Detectives with the Sheriff's Office Street crimes Unit met with Ashley Egan who stated that she wanted to provide information that could help further an ongoing investigation. Ashley was given \$ 250 dollars from the Sheriff's Office narcotics funds to be used to help develop information for the case. After Ashley received the money and clear instructions from investigators on what to do she has failed to contact Detectives or answer the phone. Ashley Egan is a known heroin user and officers have determined through other sources that Ashley took the money given to her by SCSO Detectives and used that money to buy heroin. This did occur in Shelby County, TN.
